Southwark Campus Offering all undergraduate courses.


Croydon Campus Offering Adult Nursing, Mental Health Nursing and Chiropractic.

LSBU Group

We are a part of LSBU Group: an integrated skills and innovation ecosystem in South London that provides education for local learners and innovation support for local businesses. LSBU is at the heart of this unique educational structure, which comprises secondary, Further, and Higher Education institutions. LSBU Group aims to engage students by providing career focused pathways – from Entry Level to Level 8 – offering learners a high-quality, sectorspecific education in their chosen field.

Being part of LSBU Group gives students unrivalled access to educational opportunities, advice, and guidance, as well as sought-after apprenticeships and work placements. The LSBU Group partnership is designed to work with local colleges and schools to provide continuous education and raise attainment.

LSBU Group includes:

1. London South Bank University: A diverse and modern university providing high-quality professional and technical education.

2. South Bank Academies, comprising:

- South Bank University Sixth Form The first dedicated 16-19 technical academy with employer sponsors including Skanska and Guy's and St Thomas' NHS Foundation Trust. Focused on technical qualifications, it also uses a hub and spoke model to support local schools that wish to deliver more applied options from Year 10.
- South Bank University Academy An 11–19 secondary school and sixth form with a STEAM-based curriculum.

3. South Bank Colleges, comprising:

- South Bank Technical College, based in Nine Elms, which provides advanced technical programmes for learners.
- Lambeth College, based in Clapham, which focuses on gateway qualifications and houses a specialist English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) centre.
- 4. South Bank Innovation: The commercial and enterprise arm of LSBU Group.
- 5. The Passmore Centre: An institute of professional and technical education with a focus on apprenticeships and work-based education, providing a one-stop-shop for employers' skills needs.

What is Widening Participation?

Widening Participation has been a part of UK Government education policy for decades. It is designed to address differences in progression to university between different groups, acknowledging that learners from disadvantaged backgrounds may face significant barriers when considering, applying to, and succeeding in Higher Education.

At LSBU, we work with anyone interested in Further and Higher Education, however we provide extra programmes for those learners who come from underrepresented social groups who might miss out on the opportunity to progress in their education due to circumstances out of their control.





This includes, but is not limited to:

- · Learners receiving, or eligible for, free school meals
- Disabled learners, including those with long-term illnesses
- Adult learners anyone 21 years and over interested in studying for an undergraduate degree
- Care leavers and looked after children
- Young and adult carers
- Learners with no parental/carer history of Higher Education
- Refugees and asylum seekers
- Individuals from Gypsy, Roma, Traveller, Showman and Boater communities

We are committed to challenging preconceptions, offering opportunities for learners and their supporters to explore new subjects and careers, and to using our network of academics, students, alumni and partners to support those considering Further and Higher Education.

Learners from Widening Participation groups will get priority access to our activities and bespoke support when making applications to LSBU, such as one-to-one personal statement advice. Once students have enrolled at LSBU, we provide additional support including bursaries, counselling and dedicated staff.

Widening Participation Activities

If you would like to book a Widening Participation activity for your students who meet the criteria mentioned, please get in touch. We have a wide variety of activities on offer that we would love to facilitate for your learners.

We can organise Discovery Days for Years 7 to 10 where they meet our students, have a tour of the campus, visit our fantastic gym and fitness suites in LSBU Active, explore our new library and find out what a university is all about – it's not just about the lectures! We can welcome students to our NHS Simulation Wards to interact with our life-size patient manikins and practice their CPR skills, giving them the chance to work alongside our student nurses and meet our healthcare professionals. Or bring a group of BAME young women to our 4-week after-school STEM Explorer club, and find out about robotics, forensic investigations, and what you find in an owl pellet.

We are also piloting a Fitness Outreach session in our brand-new sports facilities with our professional coaches which will be available from Autumn 2024.

Our Widening Participation Team are always happy to discuss engaging bespoke activities that will impact your pupils and open their eyes to the opportunities that Higher Education can offer. How to Book Activities

- Choose which activity or activities you would like to book.
 Please check dates (if applicable) and eligibility criteria for each activity.
- 2. Email the Student Recruitment & Outreach Team at outreach@lsbu.ac.uk with the following details:
 - a. Activity you would like to get involved in
 - b. Potential dates
 - c. Number of people in the group
 - d. School/college/group and Year group (if applicable)
- **3. We will get back to you shortly** to either confirm your booking or discuss alternative dates/details.



- **4. If the booking is confirmed** you will be sent a data collection form for each participant to complete:
 - a. Year 8 and below an online or paper data collection form for the parents/carers to complete on behalf of the participant
 - b. Year 9 and above an online data collection form for the participant to complete

Please note: all data collection forms should be completed/returned to LSBU at least **2 weeks before the activity is due to start.**

- 5. We will send you more details about the activity and reconfirm all details 5-6 weeks before the activity is due to take place. If any additional requirements are needed for participants or adults attending with them, please give us as much notice as possible.
- 6. We will see you and your students soon!

Cancellation policy

We understand that plans can change.

We therefore request that we are informed a minimum of two weeks before the event is due to take place if cancellation or rescheduling is required. If you need to change the timings of an event or the number of students that you will be bringing changes significantly (either an increase or decrease in number), we request that you also inform us a minimum of two weeks before so that we can accommodate for these changes.







Data Collection and GDPR

We collect data from learners who participate in our activities in different ways:

- Online data collection forms completed by the participant before the activity takes place for students in Year 9 and above.
- Online or paper data collection forms completed by a parent/ carer before the activity takes place for students in Year 8 and below.
- Online, paper or in-person evaluation forms after the activity has taken place e.g. feedback forms, evaluations, focus groups.
- Basic information supplied via secure platform/email from the school e.g. attendance register.

Your personal data is held securely on LSBU's CRM Salesforce, and digital engagement platforms such as Gecko and HEAT. There are a limited number of LSBU staff who have access to this data, all of whom have received data protection training. Where data is not held on our servers, we use systems that are secure, cloud based, and password protected.

University 101

Are you looking to introduce your students to university life? Eager for them to understand the benefits of Higher Education and for them to get excited about their next steps? During this on-campus day, learners will gain an insight into what it means to go to university and why it might be the right choice for them. They will find out more about the courses that are on offer at LSBU, meet current students, and have a tour of our campus and facilities. 'University 101' is a great introductory session for students who are new to the concept of university or who are unsure if continuing education after they leave school is right for them.

In this session, we will explain the differences between undergraduate degrees and degree apprenticeships, and their associated costs and benefits, so your learners can feel confident that they will pick the path that is right for them.

Workshop	Description
Why go to uni?	This session is an introduction to university. We will discuss the benefits of going to university and look at how certain careers require specific degrees. Learners will come away with an understanding of how going to university can benefit their careers, as well as their personal lives.
Choose your course	In this session, we support students in finding the right course for them. The workshop looks at entry requirements, accreditation, work experience, career prospects and how to make the most of Open Days – so learners can feel confident that they have made the right decision when they apply to university!
Pathways to your career	Want to help your students get a better understanding of the academic and career related options available to them? In this session, we will discuss Higher Education pathways and the doors that are opened by studying a particular subject. This session is perfect for classes of Level 3 students: whether that is a group taking Business, Health & Social Care, Law, or any other subject, we can take them through the opportunities that their subject presents them with and get them excited about their next steps.
Student Life at LSBU	A chance for your learners to hear from our Student Ambassadors and find out what it's really like to study at university, from the academic life to the social scene. Students will have the opportunity to ask any burning questions they may have and hear more about the real-life experiences of LSBU students.

Workshop	Description
Student Finance and budgeting at university	A workshop designed to help prospective university students understand how Student Finance works and the importance of managing your money and budgeting at university, including how to create a basic budget and how to make money go further. We will share tips on how to save money, as well as advice on how to supplement their budget as a student, and address myths and misconceptions about Student Finance.
Acing your Personal Statement	A workshop for learners currently writing their UCAS Personal Statements, to help them create a Personal Statement they can be proud of! We will look at key content to include and will identify what admissions tutors are looking for, using examples so that learners can understand how a Personal Statement comes together. We can also tailor sessions to particular subject areas for students applying to similar courses.
Study advice and developing soft skills	This workshop is designed to build learners' soft skills, such as problem-solving, communication skills, and leadership. The session aims to boost students' confidence in the short term and set them up with skills to aid their transition to Further and Higher Education.
Undergraduate Degrees vs Degree Apprenticeships	This session aims to support your learners to make informed choices about their Higher Education journey, through demystifying, informing and providing advice on undergraduate degree and degree apprenticeships options. We will explain the differences between undergraduate degrees and degree apprenticeships, and their associated costs and benefits, so your learners can feel confident that they will pick the path that is right

for them.















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Subject Specific activities

We offer a variety of qualifications at London South Bank University and within LSBU Group, and our focus is always on giving a technical education with real-world experience – meaning we favour coursework, hands-on projects, and live briefs over lengthy written exams. We also partner with industry leaders to develop our course content to make sure that we are setting students up for success in their future careers.

Our amazing academics are able to offer a variety of talks and interactive outreach sessions for schools and colleges so that interested learners can find out more about the courses on offer and can get excited about the prospect of studying here in the future!
