Student Support


The Mobility Team are here to help you at every step of the way, including:

How to apply and visas

Apply for our programme online today!

Submit your application online at **apply-international.lsbu.ac.uk** Search for "Study Abroad" and select your School. As a Study Abroad student, you will be required to take at least 2 modules from your chosen School.

As part of your application, you will need to submit:

- Academic transcript (translated into English)
- Module Selection Form
- · English language certificate
- · Copy of passport

Visa Information

To be eligible to study with us at LSBU you are required to have a valid passport for the length of the programme and to obtain the appropriate visa, if necessary, which allows you to undertake study in the UK.
